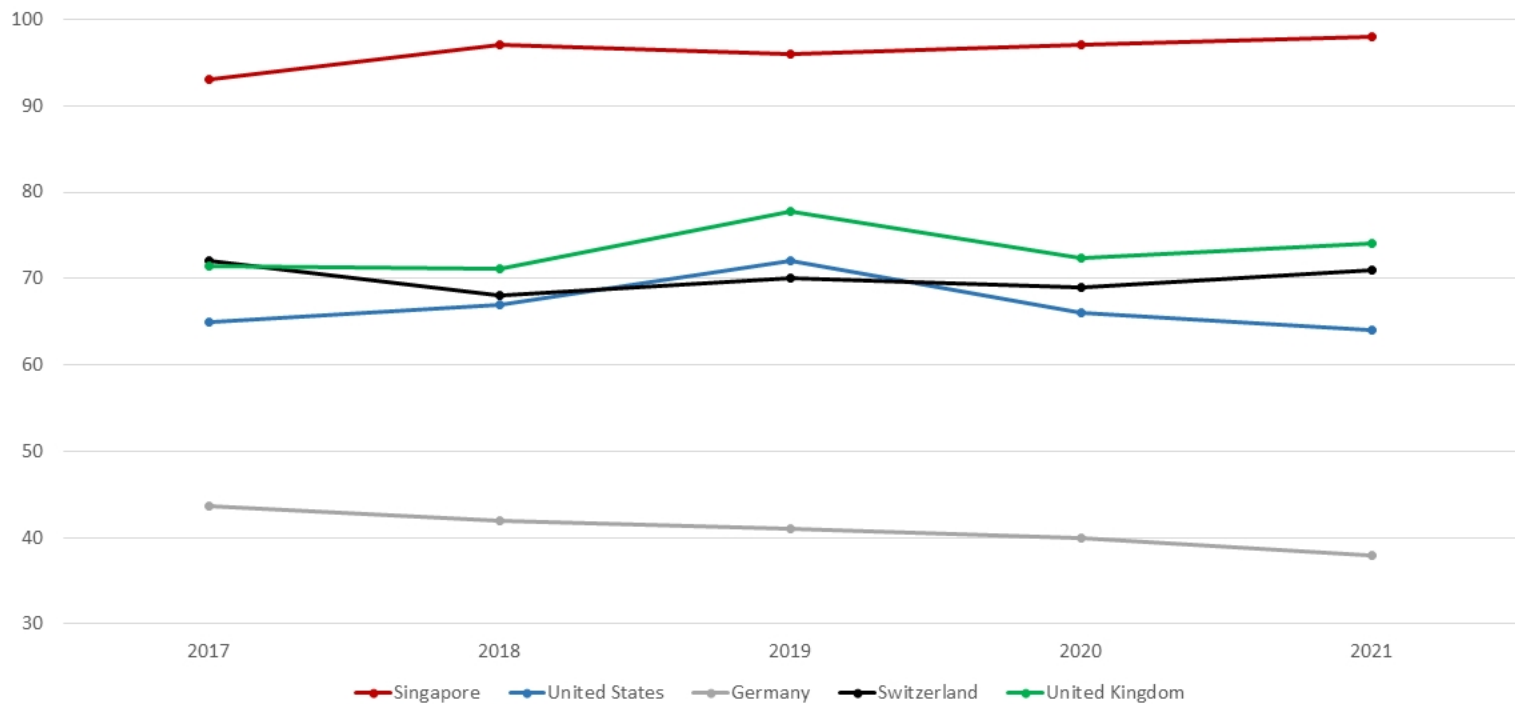

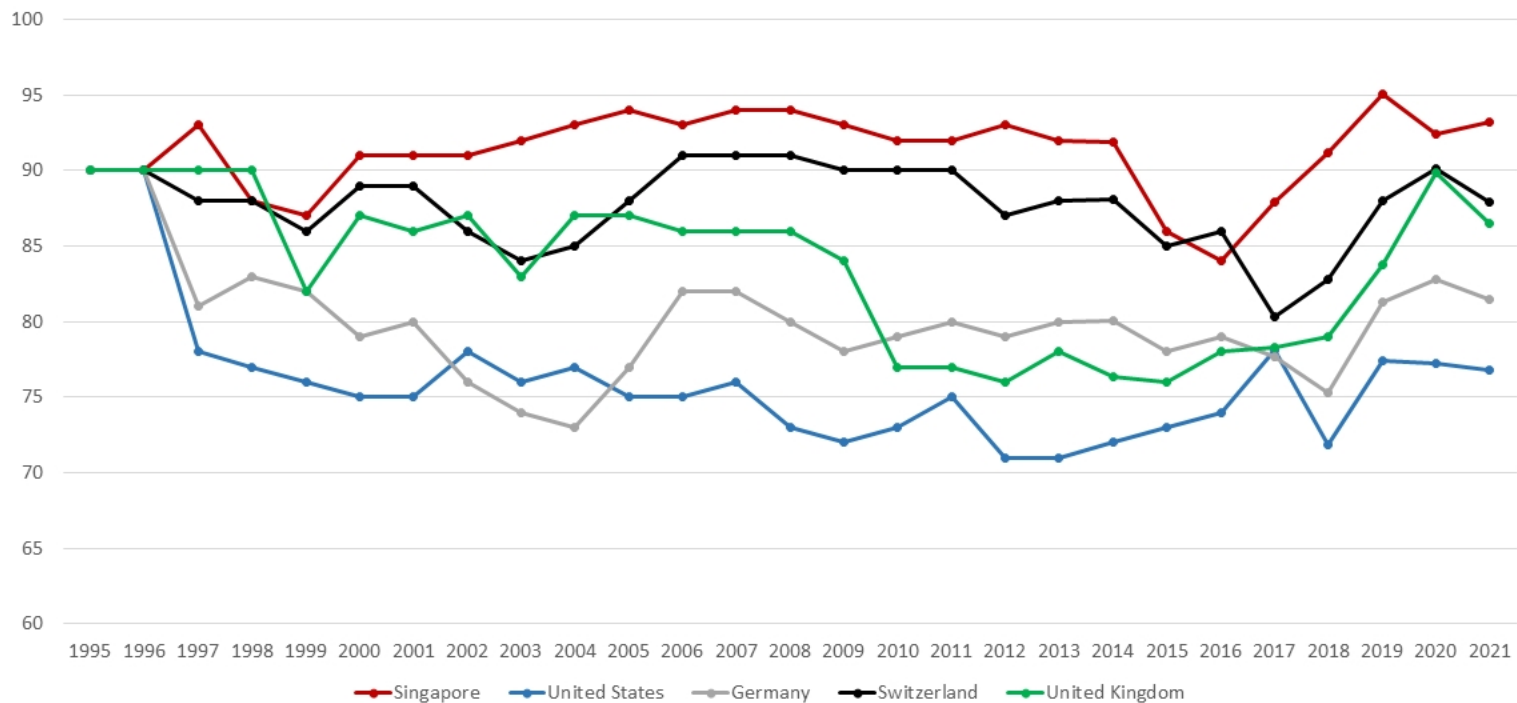

## EFFICIENT AND UNBUREAUCRATIC GOVERNMENT INDEX

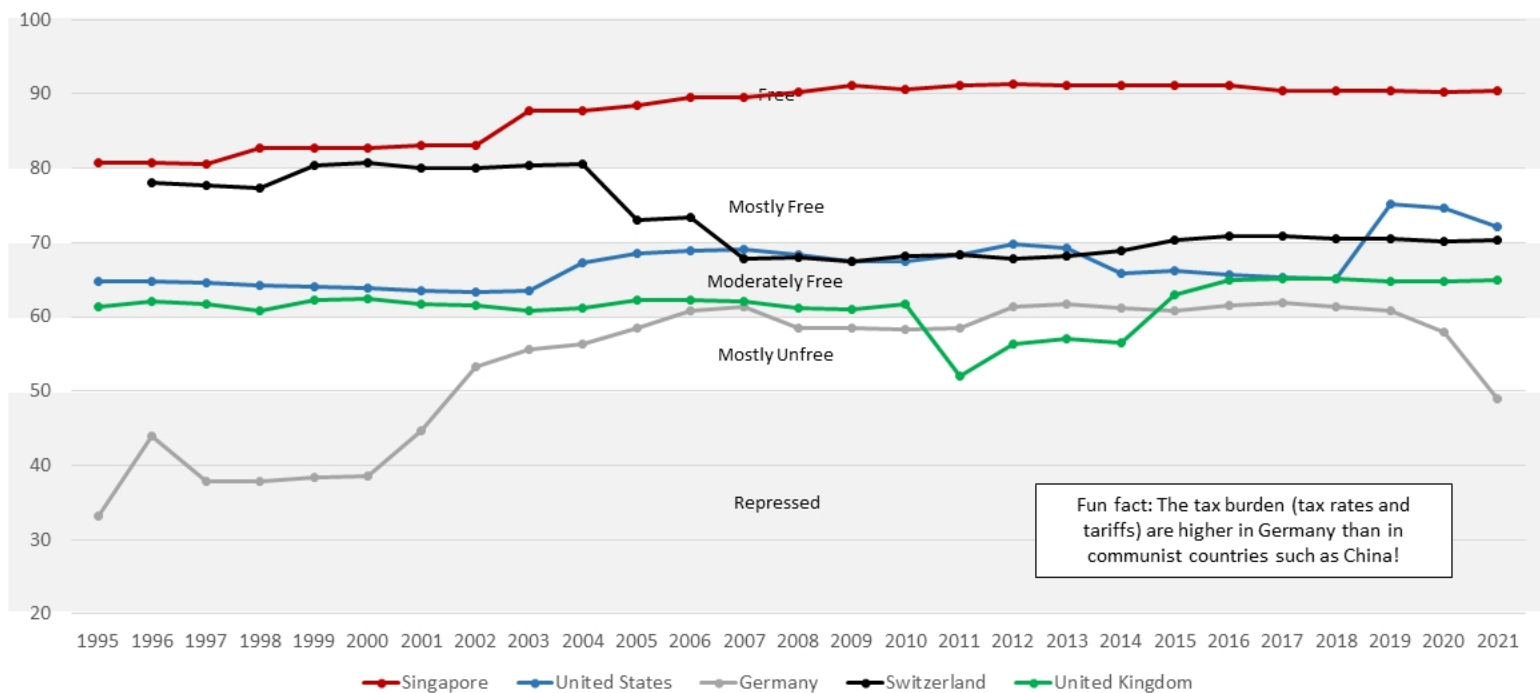


## GOVERNMENT INTEGRITY INDEX



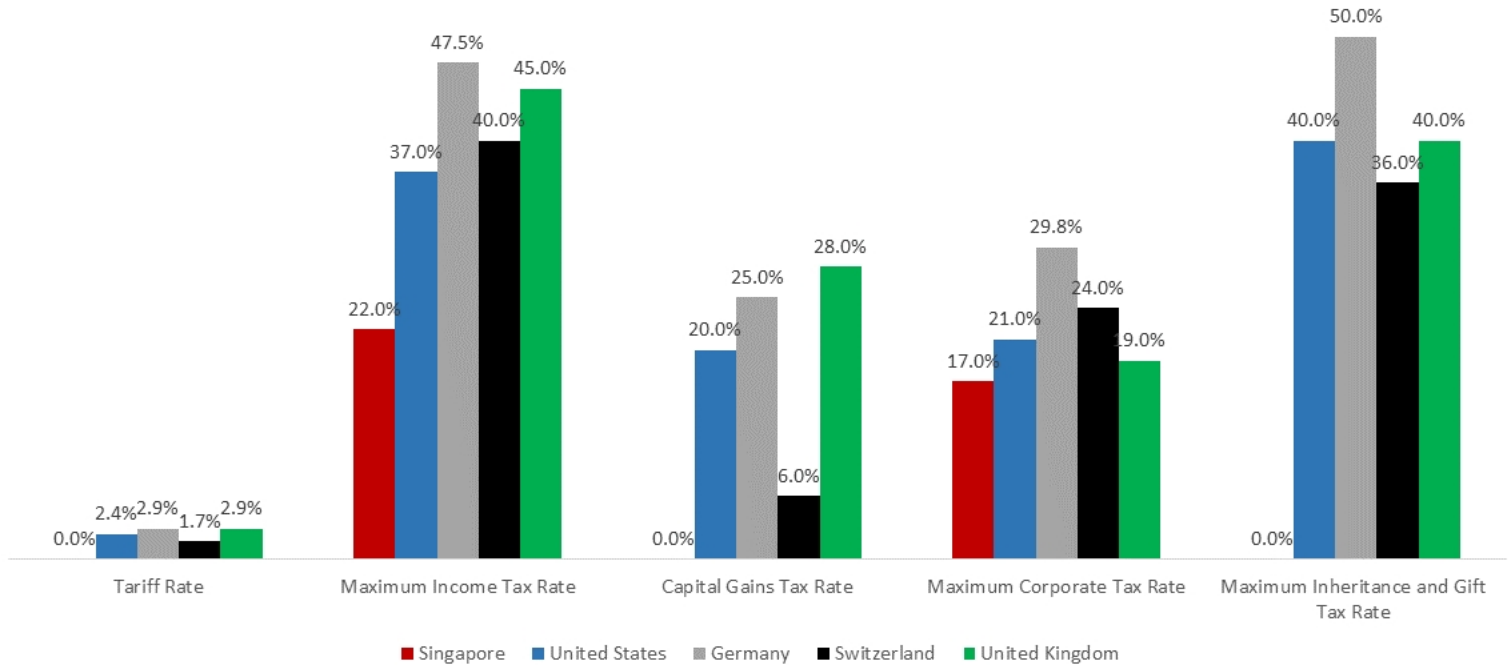

## TAX FREEDOM INDEX

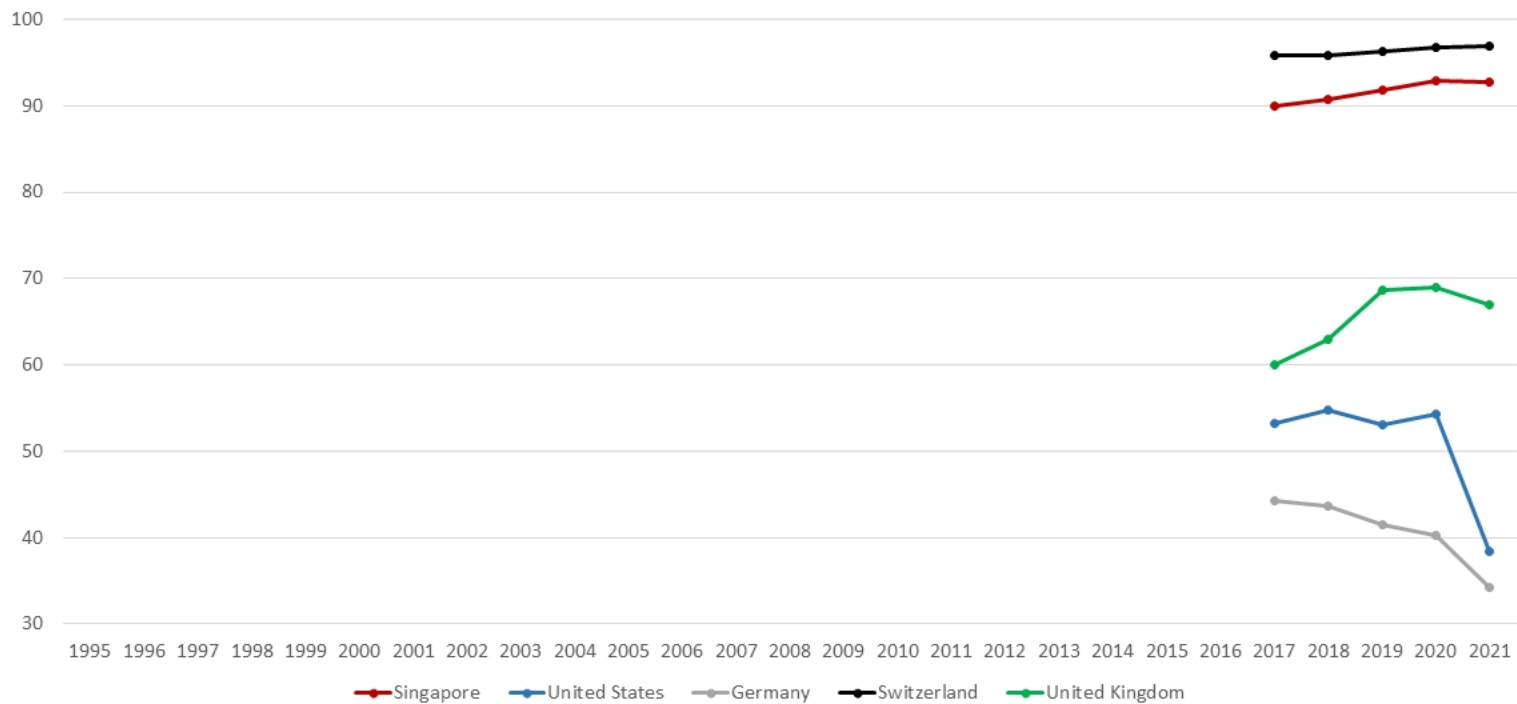


Fun fact: The tax burden (tax rates and tariffs) are higher in Germany than in communist countries such as China!

## FISCAL HEALTH INDEX



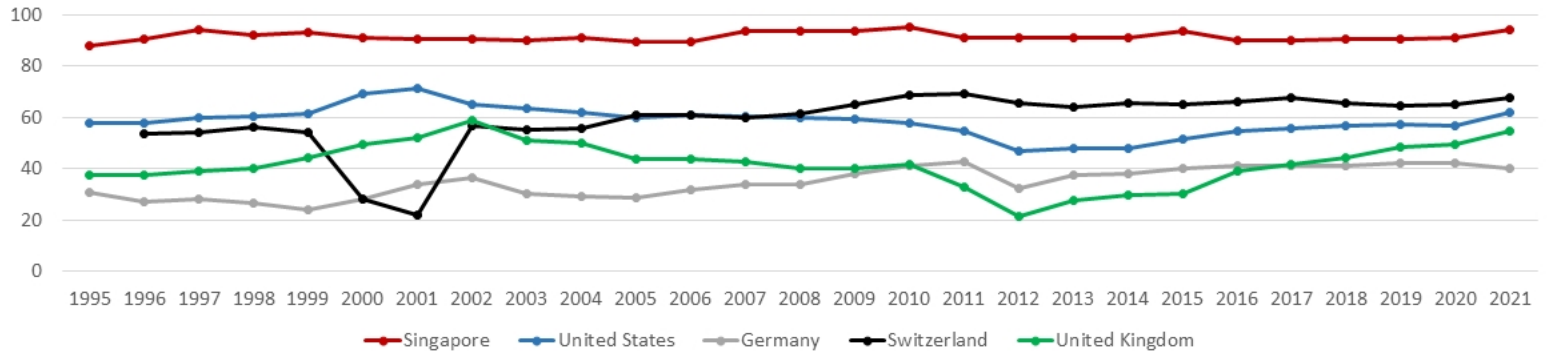

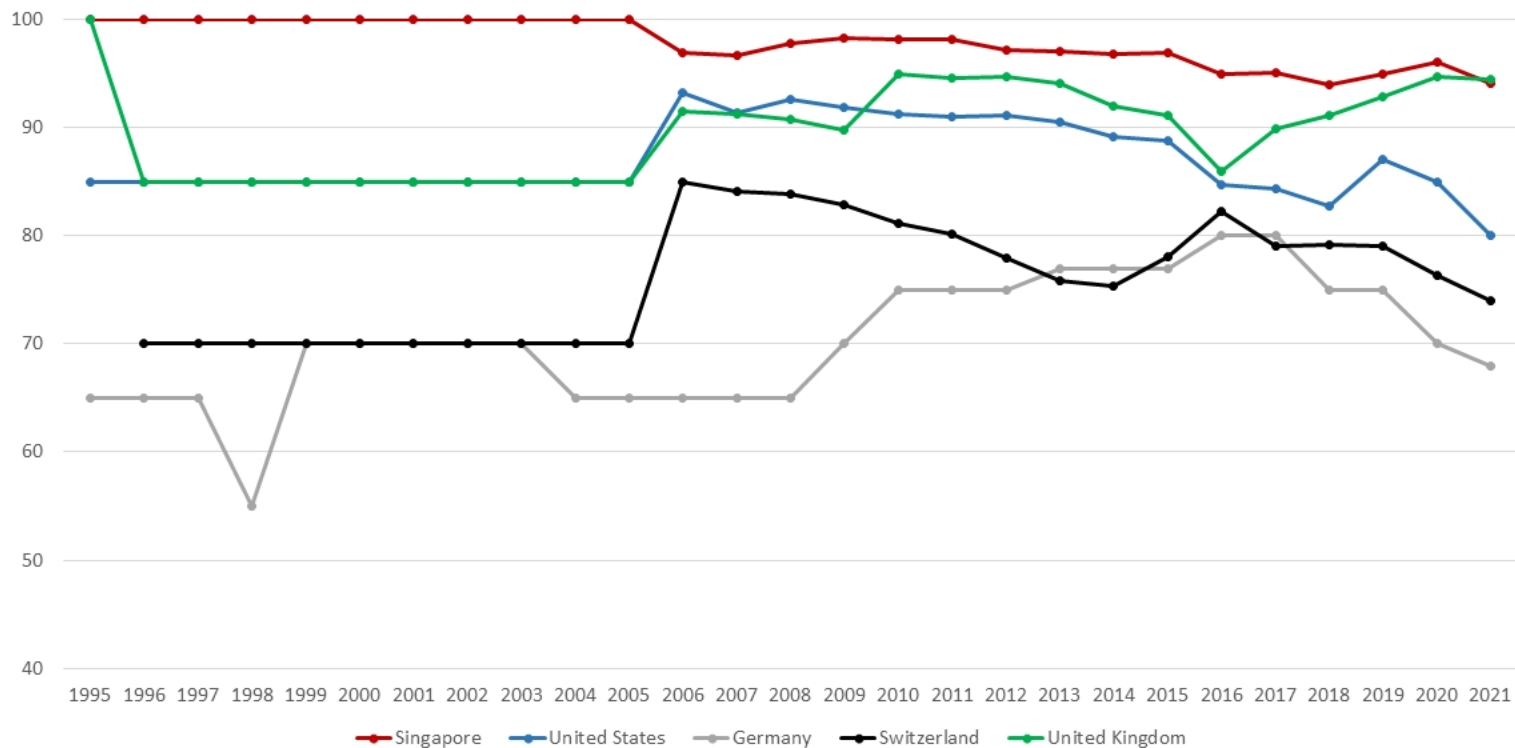
Govt. Expenditure as percentage of GDP



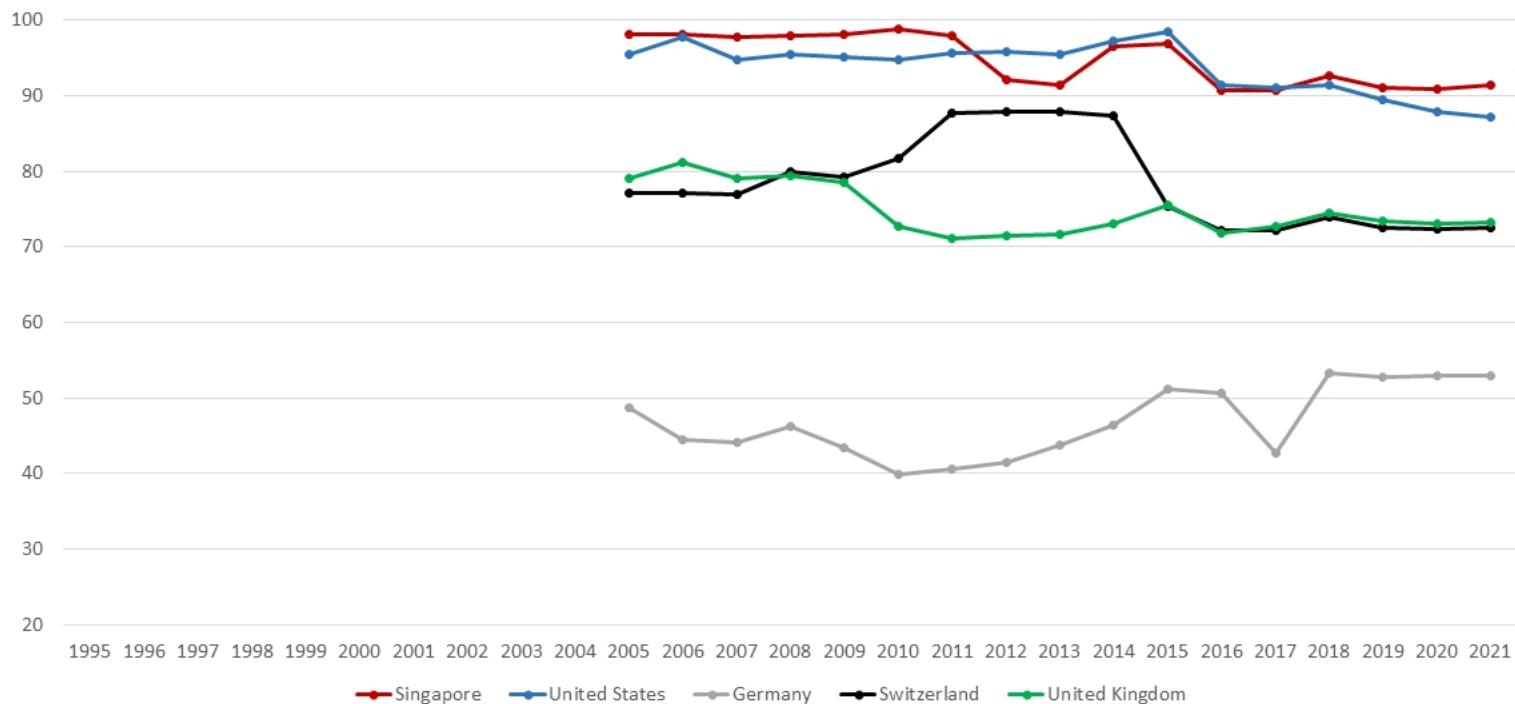
## Government Spending Score



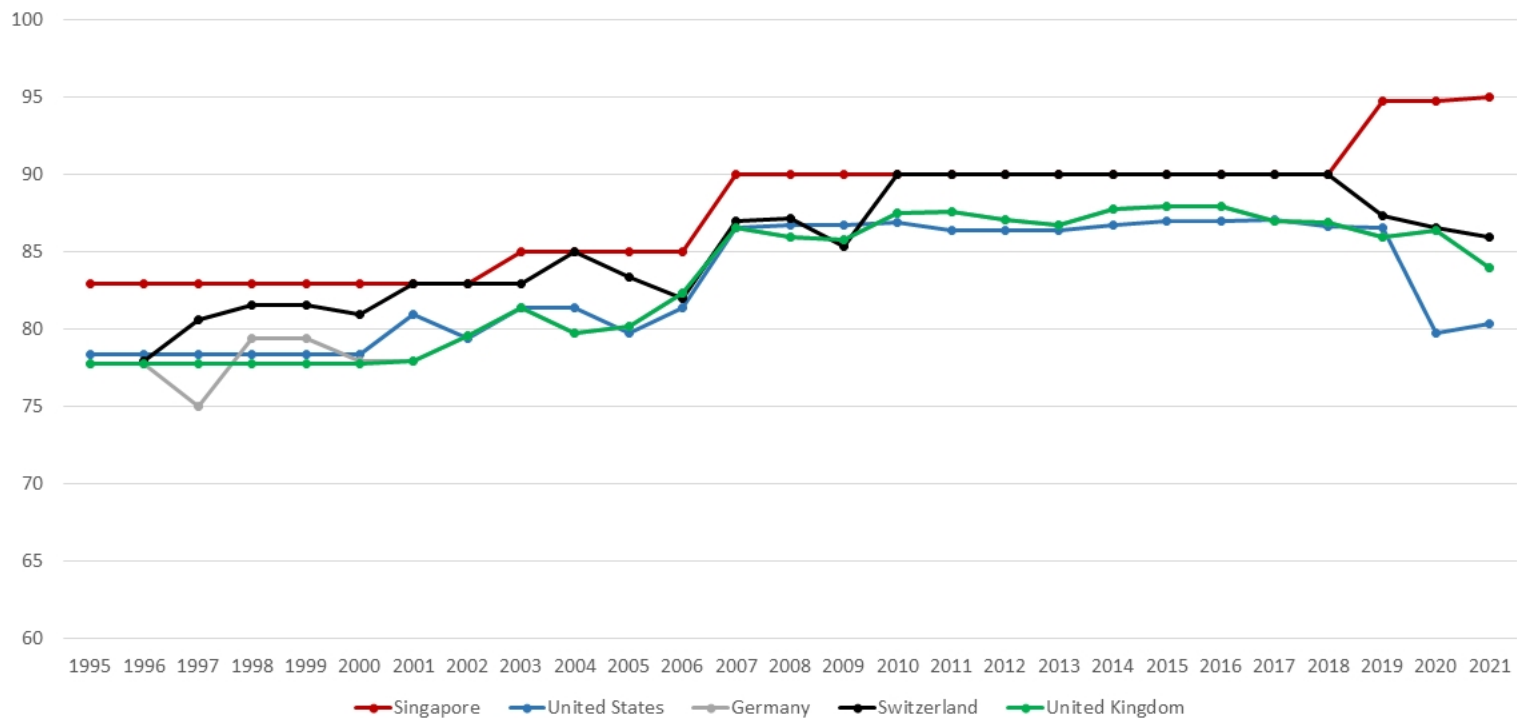
## BUSINESS FREEDOM SCORE



## LABOUR FREEDOM SCORE



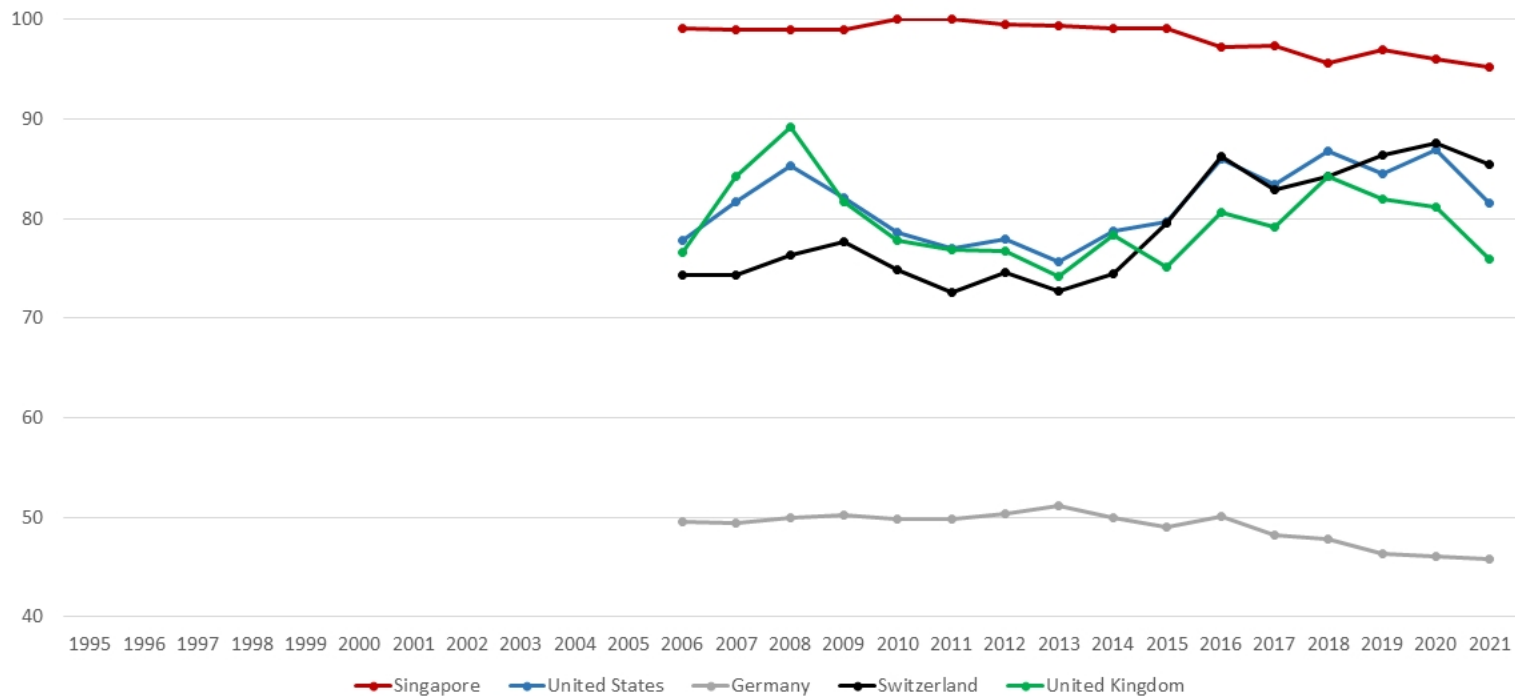
## TRADE FREEDOM SCORE

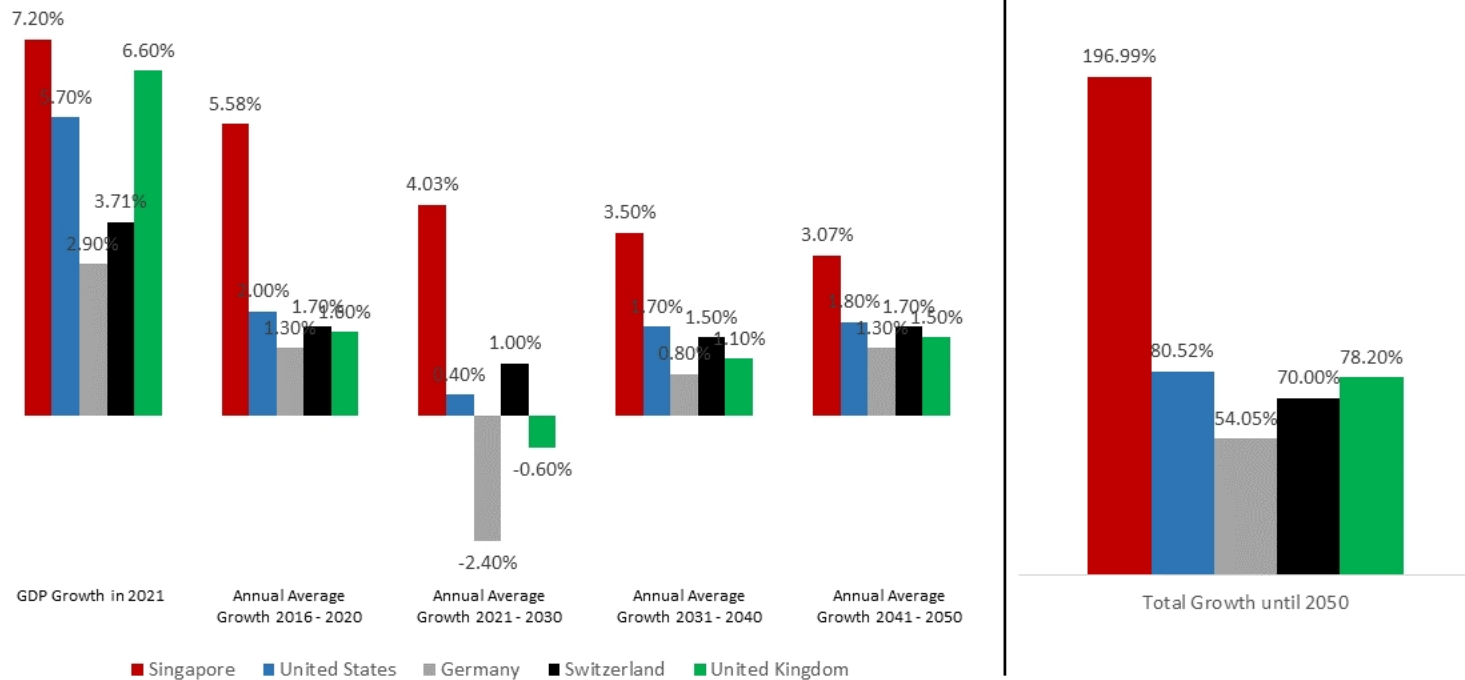
## FINANCIAL SERVICES INDEX

(This index measures a.o. the ease of starting and running a financial business, regulatory freedom and innovation support, quality and breadth of available services, market strength and financial services infrastructure)



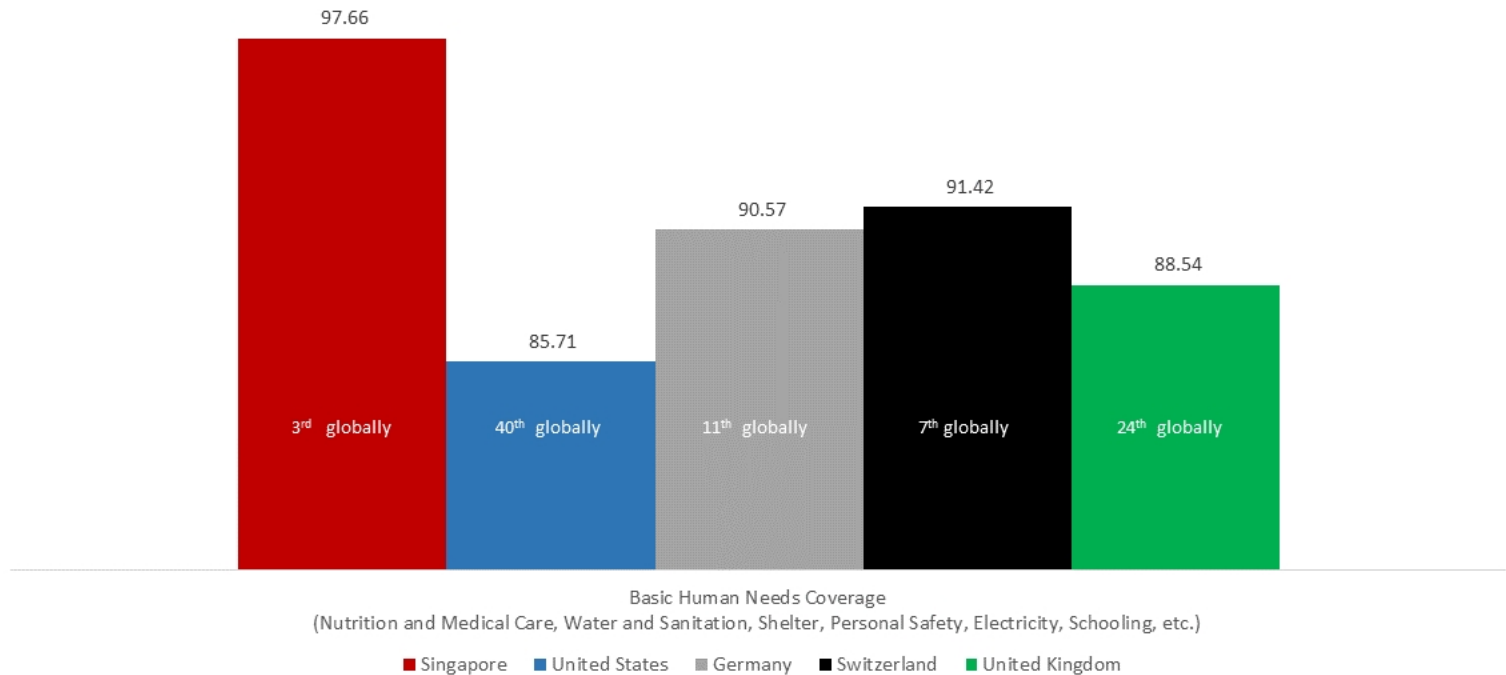
## ECONOMIC GROWTH PROSPECTS

(pre-pandemic and Ukraine war; i.e. now prospects for European countries are even way worse)

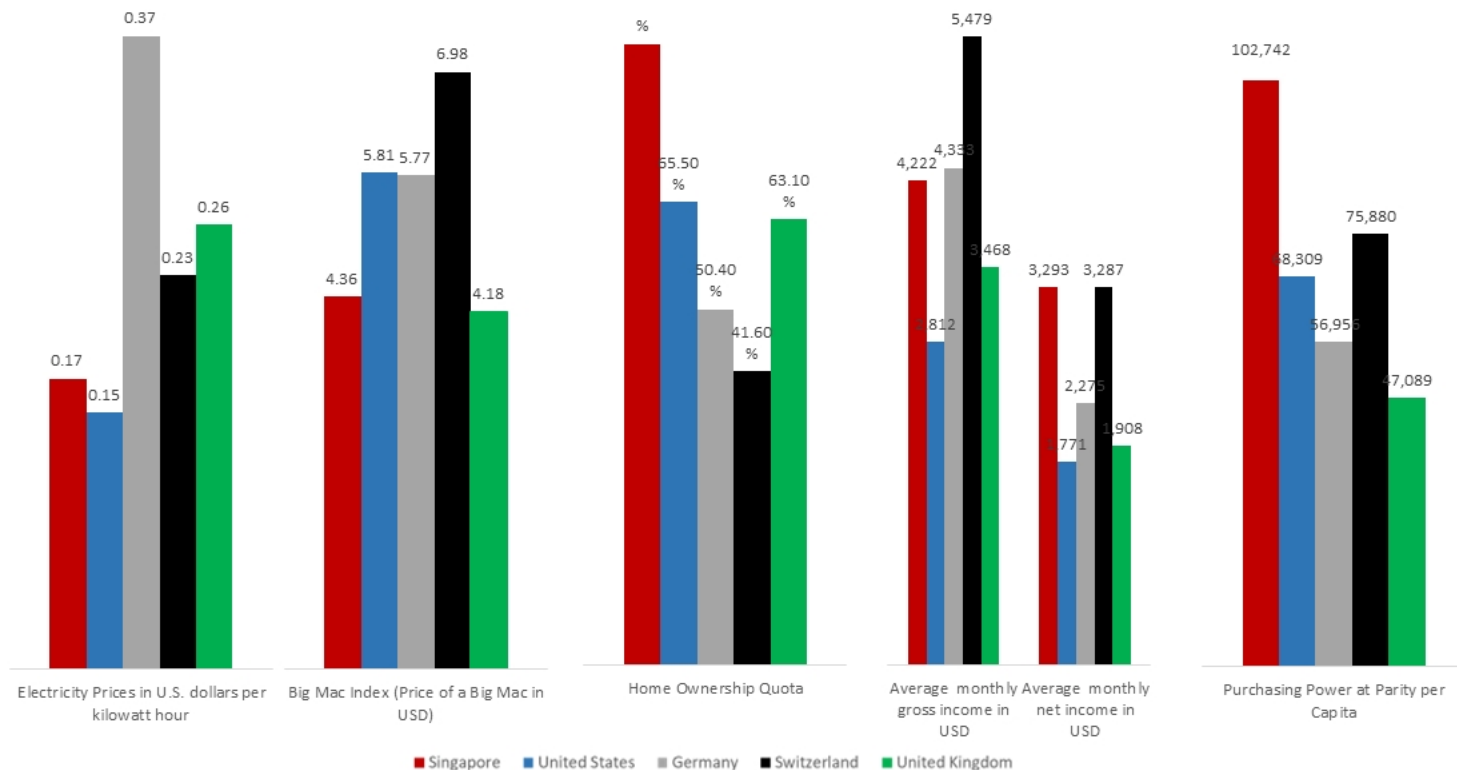


## SOCIAL WELFARE AND PROGRESS INDEX
